Attendance Policy

- Please be aware of attendance policy changes:
 - Students have 7 parent notes per semester
 - Each parent note is for 1 day ONLY
 - This means that each student will be allowed 7 total days of parent-note absences per semester
 - Doctor, dentist, or professional appointments will be excused with an appropriate excuse from that professional
 - ALL excuses MUST be turned in within 3 days of returning to school

 - If there is a chance that your child will be walking or riding a bike to or from home, please fill out the Walking Form.




Medication

- ★ Students should not keep medicines in their backpacks or lockers.




Child Nutrition
