
This will allow students and staff more time to meet the students and assess their individual needs.

Car Line Entrance

Please enter the car line from Parrish Street. This is the ONLY entrance!

Please follow the highlighted car line route when dropping off in the mornings, and picking up in the afternoons.

Please notice, the entrance from Alabama Avenue is not accessible during the morning and afternoon car line times.



Morning Routine

- 7:00 Front doors open for car riders. Students report to cafeteria.
- 7:10 Breakfast is served. Buses unload.
- 7:10 7:20 Students remain in cafeteria. 8th grade students may sit in the Aggie 4 or Aggie 5 hallway.
- 7:20 Students report to first period classrooms.
- 7:40 School begins.

Lockers

Students should visit their locker between 7:20 - 7:40, then immediately report to their first period classroom. Students may visit their locker between 7th and 8th period to pick up any belongings before leaving school for the day.

Backpacks

Students will be allowed to carry backpacks to all classes. This will allow students to move quickly from one period to the next.

Cell Phones

Cell phones are not allowed during the school day.

Students should ask permission from a teacher before using a cell phone to contact a parent.

Dress Code

Please see the AMS Student Handbook for a complete list.

Frequent Concerns:

- Shorts: All shorts, culottes, skirts, and dresses are to be halfway between the knee and groin area.
- Shirts: All shirts or blouses that expose the midriff at any time are not permitted.
- Tank Tops: All tops must have straps that measure at least 1" wide and cover both shoulders.
- Leggings: Appropriate attire must be always worn over leggings. Garments worn over leggings must be at least fingertip length or longer.
- Jeans: Pants or shorts with holes or cuts must not show skin above the allowed area.

All students will receive a free breakfast and lunch for the 2023-2024 school year.

Attendance Policy

Students are expected to report on time and attend school for the full day. Parents should make every effort to schedule doctors' and dentists' appointments after school hours. ABSENCES ARE EITHER EXCUSED OR UNEXCUSED.

Chromebooks

Each student will be issued a Chromebook for use at school AND at home. Students must return the signed ACS Technology User Agreement Form before receiving a Chromebook.

Students will be responsible for the maintenance of their Chromebook, keeping it charged and in good condition.

Academic Resources

Schoology: Schoology provides access to instructional resources and assignments at any time. Students are expected to maintain daily classroom activities, even when absent.

PowerSchool: The online and mobile access to parent and student portals helps families stay current on grades, attendance, assignments, activities, and events. If you need information on the Parent Portal, please contact the school at 256-878-2341.


